

How to Evaluate Medical Nutrition in Addiction Treatment

In my years working in behavioral health, I have seen "nutrition" in rehab often reduced to a salad bar and a multivitamin. But the science has moved far beyond this. We now know that specific metabolic interventions can rival medications in their ability to stabilize mood and reduce cravings. Beyond the Food Pyramid

When vetting a facility, ask about their nutritional philosophy. If they follow the standard government food pyramid—heavy on grains and carbs—be wary. For a recovering brain, high-carbohydrate diets can cause blood sugar spikes that mimic anxiety and trigger cravings. A sophisticated program will offer therapeutic nutritional protocols, such as low-glycemic or ketogenic options, which are proven to stabilize neural activity.

Testing, Not Guessing

A legitimate metabolic program starts with diagnostics. Does the facility run comprehensive metabolic panels? I am not talking about a basic drug screen. I mean testing for insulin resistance, inflammatory markers (like CRP and homocysteine), and micronutrient deficiencies. You cannot treat what you do not measure. A center that prescribes a diet without seeing your bloodwork is operating blindly.

The Gut-Microbiome Component

Ask specifically about how they address gut health. The research linking gut dysbiosis to addiction is overwhelming. A top-tier program will have protocols for microbiome restoration, including the use of specific probiotics, prebiotics, and gut-healing compounds like L-glutamine. This isn't just about digestion; it's about restoring the production of serotonin and GABA to treat the psychiatric aspects of addiction.

Medical Supervision

Implementing metabolic therapies—especially things like the ketogenic diet—requires medical supervision. It changes electrolyte balances and medication needs. Ensure that the facility has a medical team that understands these dynamics. This is not the job of a standard nutritionist; it requires a clinician trained in metabolic psychiatry.

The Integration Factor

Finally, look for integration. The metabolic plan should not exist in a vacuum; it should support the clinical work. For example, therapists should understand that a patient adjusting to a new metabolic protocol might experience temporary fatigue. The medical and clinical teams must communicate daily.

The Gold Standard
